New First Aid Center

Supporting the best care for the best campers and staff

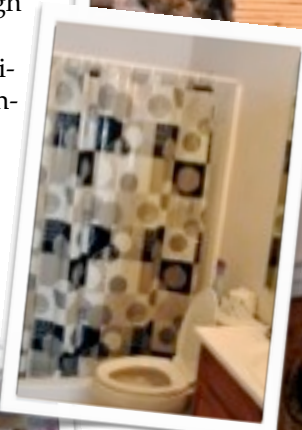
The much-anticipated First Aid Center became a reality this past summer. We were able to have the First Aid Center open for the start of our 2011 summer sessions. The center is located in front of the east bathhouse and was designed to match the exterior of the Pine Lodge. The porch provides a central spot from which you can see the campfire, pine lodge, and basketball court. It is easily accessible for all the campers.

The First Aid Center was built with input from experienced camp nurses so it would best serve the needs of our campers and staff. The center has an area for first aid, a room for the nurse to sleep in, full bathroom, beds for the sick, and a refrigerator/workspace. We also are able to air condition the First Aid Center. What a huge improvement from what we had! And we have a storage garage underneath the center for equipment and materials - another plus for the overall facility.

This center was mostly built with volunteer labor which enabled us to keep the costs very reasonable. This past spring (in lots of rain and mud) we had a variety of people working on this project. The annual work weekend was a huge boost in completing the project! Special thanks to Marlin Henley and Nate Reiser for their commitment to see this through to completion.

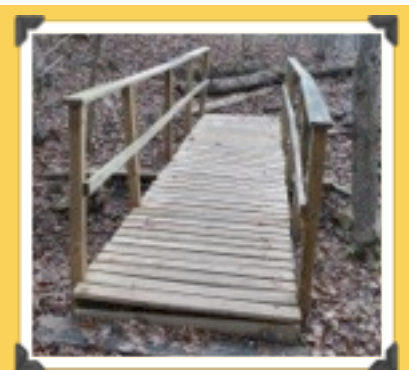
