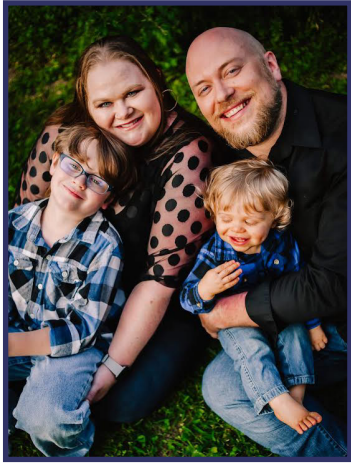

flourishes. To me, Pre-Camp is more than just a "week at camp"—it's a foundation for our children, a place where they encounter Christ, often for the very first time.

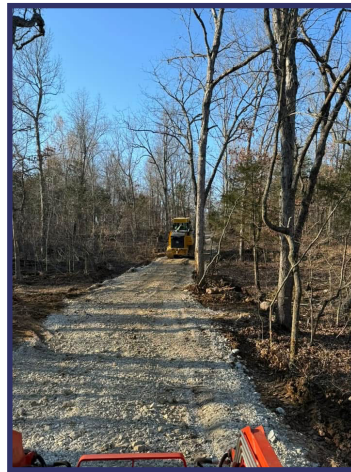

The road construction started in March 2024. The dozer work took about two weeks with some 80 loads of rock base

Nate will visit the road throughout the winter and spring to evaluate any drainage or maintenance issues. The plan is to use this road as the entrance and the original road as the exit.
